Cornwell, Chairman, and the Members of the State Council of Defense: The West Virginia Legislature, at the second extraordinary session, May 14-26, 1918, enacted a compulsory work law, a statute designed to prevent idleness and vagrancy during the period of the war. It was the first legislation of this character enacted by any State of the Union and was an expression from the legislative branch of the government defining the moral duty of those able-bodied citizens of the State who were not subject to the operation of the selective service law. It was the aim of the Legislature by this enactment to compel every male citizen who was physically able, between the ages of 16 and 60 years, to contribute not only to the support of himself and those dependent upon him, but also to the support of the men who were called into...
